JOB DESCRIPTION FOR BIBLE TEACHERS/ MISSIONARIES:

- 1. Arrive no later than 8 a.m. the day your camp starts. (Adult Counselors, Special Activity Directors, Chiefs, Cooks). Jr Staff and CIT's will train the week before the camp season begins. Everyone must attend the Staff Meeting with the Chief at 2 p.m. on Day 1.
- 2. Must be 21 years of age or older with two or more years of Christian Educator Experience (Sunday School teacher, Children's Church Leader) or be a sophomore in a Bible College.
- 3. Dress appropriately no short shorts (must have at least a 5 in. inseam), no short skirts, midriffs, halter tops, shirts with spaghetti straps. Bring long pants, a long-sleeved shirt or jacket, a hat, a water bottle, and sturdy shoes for the National Forest hike.
- 4. Bring a sleeping bag, sleeping mat or narrow air mattress, pillow, toiletries, towel, wash cloth, Bible, Pen, small notebook, flashlight, insect repellant, sun screen, and ample clothing for the week.
- 5. Complete online/in person courses in First Aid and Mandatory Child Abuse Reporting.
- 6. Submit to a background check.
- 7. Use your cell phone on Airplane mode only except in emergency situations.
- 8. Faithfully pray for all aspects of Tepee Bible Camp and for the times when you are leading.
- 9. Manifest a Christ-like attitude and behavior at all times.
- 10. Strictly adhere to the Statement of Faith.
- 11. Prayerfully prepare and be well grounded in the Word of God before coming to camp.
- 12. Dress appropriately no short shorts (must have at least a 5-inch inseam), no short skirts, midriffs, halter tops, shirts with spaghetti straps.
- 13. Be prepared and on time for all camp activities
- 14. Do not pursue romantic relationships during camp as these will distract from our purpose and inhibit the team's effectiveness.
- 15. To help avoid confusion or misunderstandings, girls minister to girls and guys minister to guys.
- 16. Prepare lessons according to the theme given by the camp.
- 17. Thoroughly and prayerfully prepare their lessons under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- 18. Be sensitive to the spiritual needs of the campers and talk to them individually.
- 19. Encourage full time Christian Service.
- 20. If staying on the camp ground, clean your quarters and teaching area at the end of camp.

*When praying with children individually, make sure you are in an area where you will be seen by other Staff Members. This is for your own protection.

- I recognize that this is an unpaid volunteer position. (However, you may send out letters to friends and relatives to supplement your income during the time you are volunteering- see Director for a sample ministry support letter).
- I further recognize Tepee Bible Camp will undertake the expenses of my room and board while at camp.
