JOB DESCRIPTION FOR MEDICAL PERSONNEL

- 1. Manifest a Christ-like attitude and behavior at all times.
- 2. Prayerfully prepare and be well grounded in the Word of God before coming to camp.
- 3. Dress appropriately no short shorts, skirts, midriffs, halter tops, shirts with spaghetti straps. Bring long pants, a long sleeved shirt or jacket, a hat, a water bottle and sturdy shoes for the hike.
- 4. Watch your example: your language, dress, how your time is spent, and especially your attitude. Do not complain in front of the campers and do not say anything unkind or derogatory about anyone.
- 5. Submit your EMT, RN, LPN or other credentials to the director to be copied for State Licensing records.
- 6. Whenever possible, while treating campers for an illness or injury, keep the solid door to the Medicine Man's office open.
- 7. Lovingly care for the injured and sick.
- 8. Be available to care for the campers at all times.
- 9. Be the final authority on the handling of injuries and sickness.
- 10. Arrive no later than 1:30 p.m. on Sunday if you are staying the entire week. OR arrive no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of your shift.
- 11. Assist with the physicals on Sunday.
- 12. Judge the tepees for cleanliness and design.
- 13. Prepare injured or ill campers for transport to medical facilities when needed. The director will transport.
- 14. Fill out incident forms for injuries or illness so that they can be sent to the insurance company and the state.
- 15. Carry the first aid kit for the hikes.
